Falcon Arrow bassist returns to Davenport

"I'm really excited to play with those guys," Reints said. "I think it'll be a fun show."

The Minneapolis-based Falcon Arrow, which bills itself as an art rock twopiece group, will perform an all-ages show Saturday, April 9, at the River Music Experience Performance Hall in downtown Davenport.

Falcon Arrow will stop in Davenport during its return leg of an East Coast tour as the band makes its way back to Minnesota.

Dave) Kemp on drums, uses looping bass riffs and drums in a combination of rolling instrumental rock and post-punk minimalism.

Reints, 30, who grew up in Davenport and graduated from Central High School in 1999, later moved to the Minneapolis-St. Paul area,

where he met Kemp, 35.

"We've been playing together for about 2 ½ years now, I guess," Reints said in a telephone interview while the band was driving from Virginia to North Carolina. The two met through an Internet classified listing. "I posted the ad, I just needed a drummer for the band, and he replied. It's worked out since then."

The band's overall sound has changed a lot over two years, but the core has stayed the same.

Falcon Arrow recently released its debut fulllength album, "Axehandle Hound," after two EPs, a self-titled release and "Cryptoscience and Hard Times."

"It was nice. The only thing we released in 2010 was a 7-inch split. But we spent most of the time writing new songs," Reints said. "Since we had this tour, we kind of had a small window of time that we had to get the album done by."

"So it's kind of a rush, but we had a pretty good grasp of all the material before we went into the studio, so it went pretty smooth."
